

DPW – Solid Waste Management Division –
Sanitary Landfill Supervisor:



The **Sanitary Landfill Supervisor** position is a professional position responsible for ensuring that the daily operations at the Broome County landfill are performed in a safe and efficient manner, as well as according to approved methods and applicable laws. The work is performed under the general supervision of the Deputy commissioner of Public Works – Solid Waste with a wide leeway allowed for the use of independent judgement in overseeing the daily operations of the landfill. More specific instructions are received for special projects regarding work to be performed, methods to be used and the work may be reviewed while in progress and upon completion. Supervision is exercised over landfill operations staff. Does related work as required.

Minimum Qualifications: Graduation from high school or possession of an equivalency diploma and five (5) years experience in solid waste management or construction including the operation of heavy equipment in excavation and grading work.

Special Requirements:

- 1) Completion of a course of instruction in solid waste management procedures within 1 year of appointment as required by State regulation 6NYCRR, Part 360.
- 2) Possession of the appropriate level Commercial Driver's License (CDL) at the time of appointment.

Broome County DPW Solid Waste Management Division provides county residents and businesses with a comprehensive program for managing solid waste in an economically sound and environmentally safe manner. Staff in this Division operate the Broome County Landfill and associated functions.

Position Details:

Position is full time (40 hours/week – hours vary)

This is a Civil Service, tested position

Position is a AFSCME – Foreman Unit 1812

Starting pay is \$31.96/hour (\$66,477/year)

- Will increase 2.5% to \$32.76/hour (\$68,139) effective 01-01-2024
- Annual and job rates are negotiated per union contract.

- 12 paid vacation days in years 1-5
- Paid sick leave accrued after 1 month of service
